

New Vision, utilizes the Accelerated Christian Education system, children learn using Packets of Accelerated Christian Education, or PACEs, mastering each before moving on to the next. Each PACE is an average of about three weeks of work.



With ACE, if a child is second- or fifth- or whatever grade level in terms of chronological age, but has trouble understanding a certain concept, he is able to stick with it until it's mastered; so there are no holes in education that can hurt him later on. Sometimes there are children who are bored in traditional age classroom because they pick things up quicker than others and need to move faster. The ACE program offers a solution to either situation by allowing children to move at their own pace within the realm of various academic subjects. Students also set their own goals. The ACE program has been around for more than 40 years and is used

ACE is a Bible-based, character-building Christian curriculum. Students begin the program by taking diagnostic tests that reveal exactly

where they stand academically in each subject, and where there may be gaps that should be filled."

Kindergarten students will begin with the *Kindergarten with Ace and Christi* program that incorporates specific activities to develop sequencing and phonetic skills, promotes auditory processing, and improves eye-hand coordination and visual perception. As a result, many kindergarteners are easily reading lower-level books.

1st graders will begin with the learning-to-read phonics program called *ABCs with Ace and Christi*. This program provides students with the tools and skills to begin reading to move into individualized instruction with their PACES.

Ace, Christi and friends are animated characters with whom children will identify. Students will also see these characters, along with the characters' families, and their community throughout their educational journey with the ACE PACE curriculum.

2nd through 8th grade students are taught how to also take responsibility for their learning. With the assistance of their supervisors (teachers), students from grade 2 through grade 8 are able to successfully move through their PACE levels in English, Literature, Word Building/Spelling, Math, Science, and Social Studies.

The students are taught how to set and achieve daily educational goals and learn lifelong skills in time management and organization. Upon completion of their 8th PACE level, New Vision Christian Academy students are well prepared for High School and have developed the necessary study habits to be academically successful beyond graduation.


